<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP – ARTICLE II, SECTION 2.</p> <p>A person who is an owner or part owner of a sailboat sailed on Crystal Lake is eligible for Active membership in the Club. Active membership entitles a member in good standing to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Enter a sailboat in club sponsored races and sail as skipper or crew, b) Serve as a director of the corporation and as an officer of the Club, c) Vote in elections and other matters brought before the members by the Board of Directors, d) Use and enjoy all club facilities including dockage and storage of boats and trailers, overnight camping in designated areas, and use of the clubhouse and its facilities and grounds, e) Participate in all activities sponsored by the Club and authorized by the Board of Directors, f) Invite one or more guests to accompany the member to the Club and to participate in club activities including sailing on a member's boat in club sponsored races. <p>Persons included in an Active membership are the owner or part owner of the sailboat, his or her spouse or significant other living at the same residence, and all natural, adopted and step-children, or court-appointed wards, under the age of 23 years old. Each is eligible for full membership benefits and privileges, except that there is only one vote per membership in all club elections and other matters brought to the members for vote by the Board of Directors.</p>			
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP – ARTICLE II, SECTION 3.</p> <p>A person who does not own a sailboat sailed on Crystal Lake and who demonstrates an interest in sailing is eligible for Associate membership in the Club. Associate membership entitles a member in good standing to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Sail as skipper or crew on a sailboat entered in club races, b) Use and enjoy all club facilities, except for the dockage and storage of boats and trailers, in the same manner as provided for active members, c) Participate in all activities sponsored by the Club and authorized by the Board of Directors, d) Invite one or more guests to accompany the member to the Club and to participate in club activities, including sailing on a member's boat in club sponsored races. <p>Persons included in an Associate membership are the applicant, his or her spouse or significant other living at the same residence, and all natural, adopted and step-children, or court-appointed wards, under the age of 23 years old. Each is eligible for full Associate membership benefits and privileges, except that Associate members are not eligible to vote in club elections and other matters brought the members for vote by the Board of Directors, and Associate members are not eligible to hold elective or appointed office.</p>			
	<p>INITIATION FEE – ARTICLE II, SECTION 1.</p> <p>The one-time initiation fee for Active or Associate Membership is \$125. The initiation fee is non-refundable once membership is approved, and cannot be prorated. A suspended member is not required to submit another initiation fee upon reinstatement to good standing. A member who is terminated, and a member who voluntarily leaves the club for more than three years, must submit the full initiation fee upon making a new application for membership</p>
